### Potential Catastrophic Loss List Requiring Notification ICD – 9 Codes

#### **Guidelines for identifying potential catastrophic losses which require notification**

The specific diagnoses listed below are key trigger indications of potentially catastrophic losses. In addition, the following acute medical situations warrant close review and may require case management consultation. Please notify Rockport Benefits of all Plan Participants who have been diagnosed with, treated for, or fall under any of the categories below during the current Benefit Period.

1. Transplants – liver, renal, heart, lung, pancreas, bone marrow and any combinations and transplant evaluation testing
2. Hospitalization of a covered person during the past 12 months including:
  - Seven (7) days or greater length of stay request
  - Multiple hospitalizations (3 or more)
  - Interim bills have been received
  - Billed charges exceed \$40,000
3. Request for transfer to a rehabilitation facility
4. Hyperalimentation (TPN)
5. Home IV antibiotic therapy for longer than 4 weeks
6. Substance abuse/mental nervous related charges greater than \$25,000
7. Specialty pharmacy drugs greater than \$25,000 per script
